For further information concerning **visa** necessary for your scholarship stay in the Czech Republic, contact please the Czech Embassy in your country. Please, **contact your CEEPUS coordinator/partner of your host institution** two weeks before your departure at the latest – otherwise we cannot ensure your **accommodation**.

You can see **the scholarship rate** in your application after awarding the scholarship.

It is for students – Bc. and Mgr. studies 7 000,- CZK/ month;
students – doctoral studies 7 500,- CZK/ month;
teachers900,- CZK/ day (or 27 000,- CZK/ month).

Concerning the medical insurance in the Czech Republic, the citizens of the EU member states with a European health insurance card have a claim on free health care (on request, they can receive the CEEPUS medical care card from the NCO-CZ as the citizens of EU non-member state do). Citizens of EU non-member states are requested to collect a medical care card and a letter informing a doctor here in the Czech Republic – staying in Prague, in the National CEEPUS Office, and staying in other towns, at the host institution. These documents cannot be sent by post.
